

Advisory Note for - Holi Programme 2022

'Holi' will be celebrated in Dayalbagh, all Branches in India and abroad on **Friday the 18th March, 2022.**

All Satsangis would, as a precautionary measure, celebrate **2022 Holi** in their respective Branches/Satsang Centres/Area Satsang/Private Group Satsangs/Individually and **would not travel to Dayalbagh, Agra** for the same **except as provided** subsequently in this Advisory Note and subject to any binding directions of the Central/State/Local Government Authorities. **Audio/Video transmission** (as per extant guidelines) would be available to them through the e-Satsang Cascade.

1. **50% of the eligible Initiated Satsangis at each Branch, below the age of 70 years, duly certified by the Branch Secretary, who have not attended Basant-2022, who are fit and without symptoms of cough, cold and fever can come to Dayalbagh on the occasion of Holi on 18th March, 2022 for seva. However, those with cough, cold, and fever will have to be certified medically fit at the Branch level locally through Centre In-charge / Branch Secretary/ Regional Secretary or Regional President.**
2. **For this purpose, the assessment of the medical fitness of such Satsangis must be carried out by a doctor with minimum MBBS qualification (with details like Registration Number) through any one of the above authorized functionaries.**
3. **A list of all asymptomatic Branch members and those assessed medically and found fit should be forwarded by the authorities mentioned above to Dr. S.K. Satsangi, Medical Officer In-charge, Saran Ashram Hospital (email- sah.dayalbagh@gmail.com).**
4. **Dr. S.K. Satsangi, Medical Officer In-charge, Saran Ashram Hospital will assess the report and certify the fitness of individual Satsangis and revert with this information to the originator. Satsangis concerned should travel to Dayalbagh ONLY once this fitness certification is received from Dayalbagh. A copy of this should also be presented at the Registration Centre at the time of getting the TVC made.**
5. **Before and during travel and even afterwards, they must observe all precautions - such as, wearing mask, helmet and observing hand-hygiene and social distancing norms. They should bring Branch Identity Card or Identification letter from the Branch Secretary.**
6. **Additionally Satsangis under following categories are allowed to attend Holi , 2022 in Dayalbagh: a) Residents of Dayalbagh / Sabha Members / Employees/ Sewaks/ Part time Sewaks of Sabha and Societies – their spouses and Children with their spouses and dependent Children. b) Members of Holy Families. c) Licensees of Radhasoami Nagar Society & R.S. Nagar Vikendra, along with their initiated spouses.**
7. **Doctors/paramedic staff/others in Saran Ashram Hospital should take proper care and protection against COVID-19 (Corona Virus) and Hospital premises should be regularly sanitized. Dr.S.K.Satsangi, Medical Officer In-charge, Saran Ashram Hospital would strictly enforce the instructions for preventive and other requirements pertaining to COVID-19 as have been circulated to Regions.**
8. **DB Residents/others would not be distributed Preeti Bhoj from Dayal Bhandar on the occasion of Basant except those who regularly take meals from Dayal Bhandar. Dayalbagh residents who are non-regular diners of Dayal Bhandar and all others are advised to cook Preeti Bhoj at their respective homes.**
