

Advisory Note for - Holi Programme 2025

'Holi' will be celebrated in Dayalbagh, all Branches in India and abroad on **Friday** the **14th March, 2025**.

All Initiated Satsangis (with UID & completed biometrics) who are fit and without **symptoms of COVID-19 like cough, cold and fever, as certified by a registered practitioner of Modern Medicine and / or Ayush (with registration number) and additionally examined by Saran Ashram Hospital, can come to Dayalbagh on the occasion of Holi on 14th March, 2025 for Seva. Those with cough, cold and fever, and / or any other symptomatic cases shall not come to Dayalbagh at all.** (As advised in Sabha's letter dated 18.04.2022, anyone found to be suffering from these symptoms shall be asked to return immediately and all Branch members of that particular Branch shall be debarred from visiting Dayalbagh till further notice).

1. Before and during travel and even afterwards, they must observe all precautions such as wearing mask and helmet, observing hand-hygiene and social distancing norms. They must bring Branch Identity Cards or Biometric Cards.
2. Additionally, Satsangis under following categories are allowed to attend Holi 2025 in Dayalbagh: **a)** Residents of Dayalbagh / Sabha Members / Employees/ Sewaks/ Part time Sewaks of Sabha and Societies – their spouses and Children with their spouses and dependant Children. **b)** Members of Holy Families. **c)** Licensees of Radhasoami Nagar Society & R.S. Nagar Vikendra, along with their initiated spouses.
3. Doctors/Paramedic staff/others in Saran Ashram Hospital should take proper care and protection against COVID-19 (Corona Virus), and Hospital premises should be regularly sanitized. Dr.S.K.Satsangi, Medical Officer In-charge, Saran Ashram Hospital should strictly enforce the instructions for preventive and other requirements pertaining to COVID-19 pandemic as have been circulated to Regions.
4. DB Residents and other local residents would **not** be distributed Preeti Bhoj from Dayal Bhandar on the occasion of Holi, except those who regularly take meals from Dayal Bhandar. Dayalbagh residents who are non-regular diners of Dayal Bhandar and all other local residents are advised to cook Preeti Bhoj at their respective homes.
